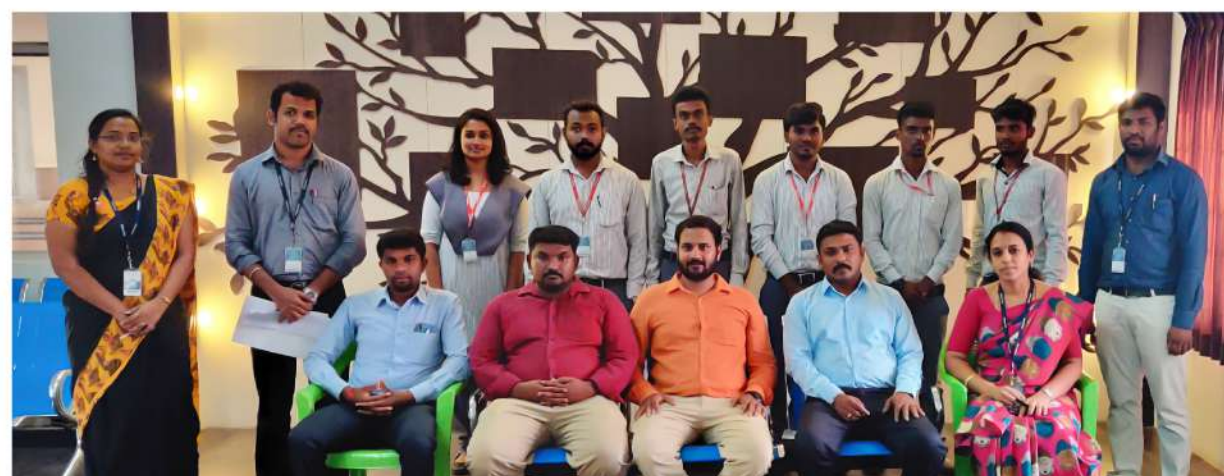

The projects of the students were judged and evaluated by the respected faculty expertise of

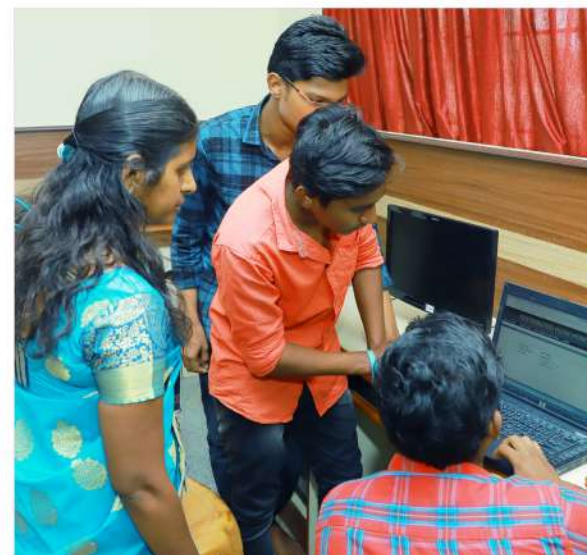
