#### **TENSES**

A verb indicated action, condition or process. The term 'tense' is used to refer to different forms of the verb indicating time of action. Only a person, having a good understanding of tense will be able to write and speak correctly without any ambiguity. Those who do not stick to a particular structure for a particular purpose, may intend to say something, but it may be interpreted the other way. This brings out the fact that it is mandatory to have a clearconcept about the use of different tense structures for different purposes of time and action.

The following table shows the different forms of the verb in various tenses.
